Educational Excellence Committee (EEC)

- The committee's members shall include the EEC Chair and the chairmen of the following Committees: Awards, Communications and Publicity, Beginning/Early Career Teacher Support, Finance, Membership Growth/Support, Music and Arts, Nominations, Professional/Leadership and World Fellowship/Community Support.
- 2. The EEC is the "umbrella" under which all other committees fall. The committee's decisions shall be guided by the Society's mission and purposes and the chapter's vision and goals.
- 3. The committee is to
 - a. plan chapter programs and promote activities designed to enhance the professional and personal growth of women educators and excellence in education;
 - b. promote Society activities at International and State levels that increase the personal and professional pride of members;
 - c. emphasize member development and involvement;
 - d. recognize the value of fine arts in education and chapter events;
 - e. assist designated committees represented on the EEC to oversee the planning and presentation of one program during the biennium, the Executive Board handling the first and last program;
 - f. encourage involvement of members in legislative action affecting education;
 - g. emphasize global perspectives and educational excellence worldwide.
