

Educational Excellence Committee (EEC)

1. The committee's members shall include the EEC Chair and the chairmen of the following Committees: Awards, Communications and Publicity, Beginning/Early Career Teacher Support, Finance, Membership Growth/Support, Music and Arts, Nominations, Professional/Leadership and World Fellowship/Community Support.
2. The EEC is the "umbrella" under which all other committees fall. The committee's decisions shall be guided by the Society's mission and purposes and the chapter's vision and goals.
3. The committee is to
 - a. plan chapter programs and promote activities designed to enhance the professional and personal growth of women educators and excellence in education;
 - b. promote Society activities at International and State levels that increase the personal and professional pride of members;
 - c. emphasize member development and involvement;
 - d. recognize the value of fine arts in education and chapter events;
 - e. assist designated committees represented on the EEC to oversee the planning and presentation of one program during the biennium, the Executive Board handling the first and last program;
 - f. encourage involvement of members in legislative action affecting education;
 - g. emphasize global perspectives and educational excellence worldwide.
